Please accept this letter as my formal; resignation as Vice-Chair of Oahu intergroup, effective 21 June 2026.

The trust you placed in me to serve this Fellowship is something I will carry with me long after I leave this position. The opportunity to work alongside so many dedicated trusted servants has strengthened my recovery, broadened my understanding of service, and reminded me time and again why Alcoholics Anonymous continue to save lives.

This decision has not been an easy one. Due to career development requirements associated with my professional life and my upcoming relocation to Louisiana, I am no longer able to commit the time, presence, and attention that this position deserves. As difficult as it is to step away, I believe our principles call us to place the needs of the Fellowship ahead of our personal attachments to a position, and it is time for another trusted servant to take the helm.

I want to express my deepest gratitude and aloha to everyone who has allowed me to serve. Thank you for your trust, your patience your guidance, and your friendship. Whether we agreed on every issue or not, I have always been grateful for the opportunity to stand shoulder-to-shoulder with people whose common purpose is carrying the message to the alcoholic who still suffers.

While I may be leaving Hawaii and stepping down as Vice-Chair, I am not leaving service. AA has given me a life beyond anything I could have imagined, and I remain committed to giving back wherever I am planted next. The spirit of recovery, unity, and service that I have experienced here on Oahu will travel with me to Louisiana and beyond.

Thank you for allowing me to be your trusted servant. It has truly been a privilege and an honor to serve this Fellowship. I leave this position with a full heart, immense gratitude, and confidence that Oahu Intergroup will continue to thrive in the hands of those who answer the call to serve.
